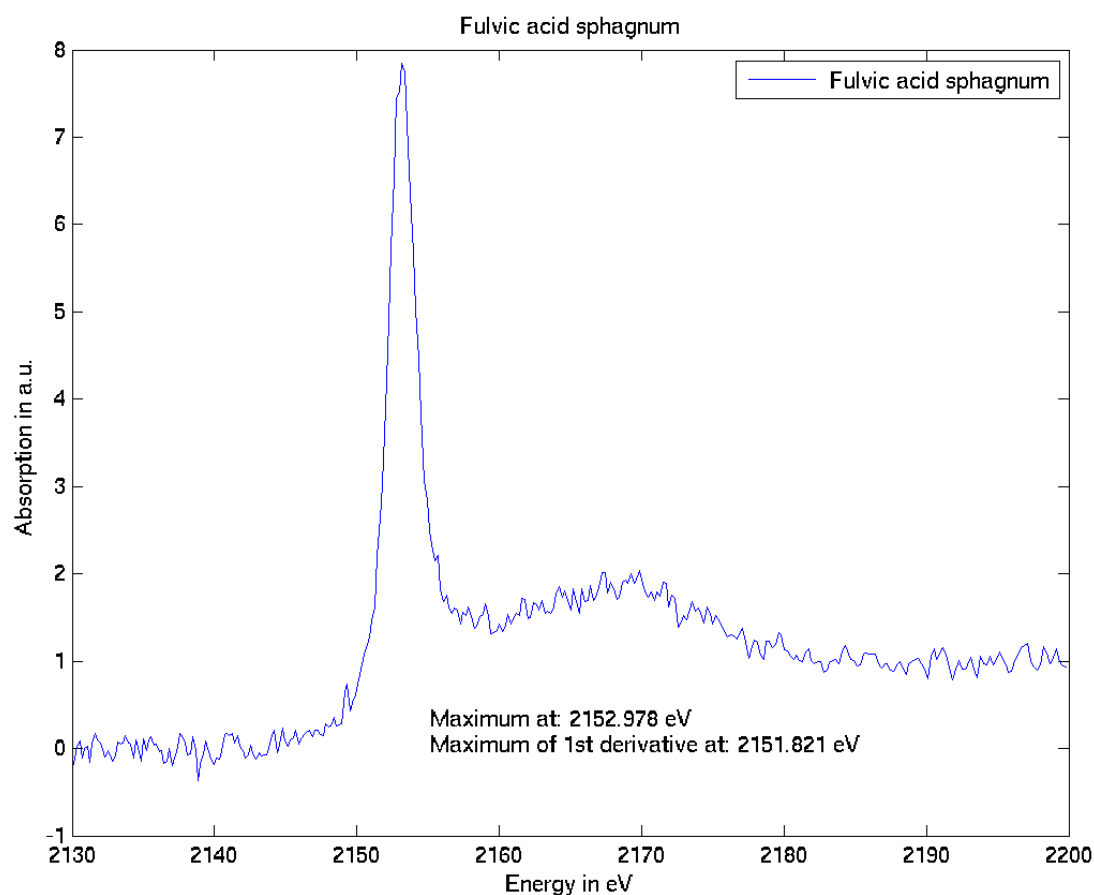


## Fulvic acid from sphagnum



Phosphorus type: **terrestrial organic phosphorus**

Origin: **Extracted from sphagnum peat (ISTERRE, Grenoble, France)**

Acquisition mode: **fluorescence**

Monochromator: **Si(111)**, calibrated in energy by fixing the position of the maximum of the white-line of hydroxyapatite ( $\text{Ca}_5(\text{PO}_4)_3(\text{OH})$ ) at **2152.7 eV**

Max of the “white-line” (s → p electronic transition) at **2152.978 eV**

Max of the first derivate (taken for normalisation) at **2151.821 eV**
