“ Radiation Therapy with Synchrotron Radiation”

18-21 MAY 2014



SCOPE:

The first multidisciplinary school on “Radiation Therapy with Synchrotron Radiation” will be organized at the ESRF, Grenoble (France) on 18-21 May. The school is financed by the “SYRA3”- TD1205 COST Action (www.syra3.eu).

Three main subjects will be dealt with in this first edition: Biology and Medicine of X-ray Radiation Therapy, Dosimetry and Image Guidance, Dose Enhancement Effects .

The school will include theoretical and practical sessions.
